U.S. News & World Report: 2009 Highlights

Stanford was ranked #2 overall, tied with Harvard (after #1 Yale).

Adjustments:

- Columbia rose to #4 from #5 last year
- NYU dropped to #5 from #4 last year
- Boalt rose from #8 last year to #6
- Northwestern rose to #9 from #12
- UVA rose to #9 from #10
- Duke dropped to #12 from #10
- Michigan dropped to #9 from #8
- UCLA dropped to #16 from #15
- Vanderbilt rose to #15 from #16

Specialty Areas:

Of the 9 law specialty areas, **Stanford** ranked in the top 10 in 2 categories like last year (IP/still #2 and Environmental Law/dropping one spot to #7). **Stanford** moved up from #20 to #13 in Clinical Training, dropped from #14 to #16 in International Law, rose to #15 in Dispute Resolution from not being ranked last year, and stayed at #13 in Tax Law. **Stanford** was not ranked at all in Health Law, Trial Advocacy, and Legal Writing.

Law School Diversity:

Stanford ranked #17, up from #20 last year (0.53, Asian-American 14%). There are no other top-tier schools ranked above, except Northwestern at #12.

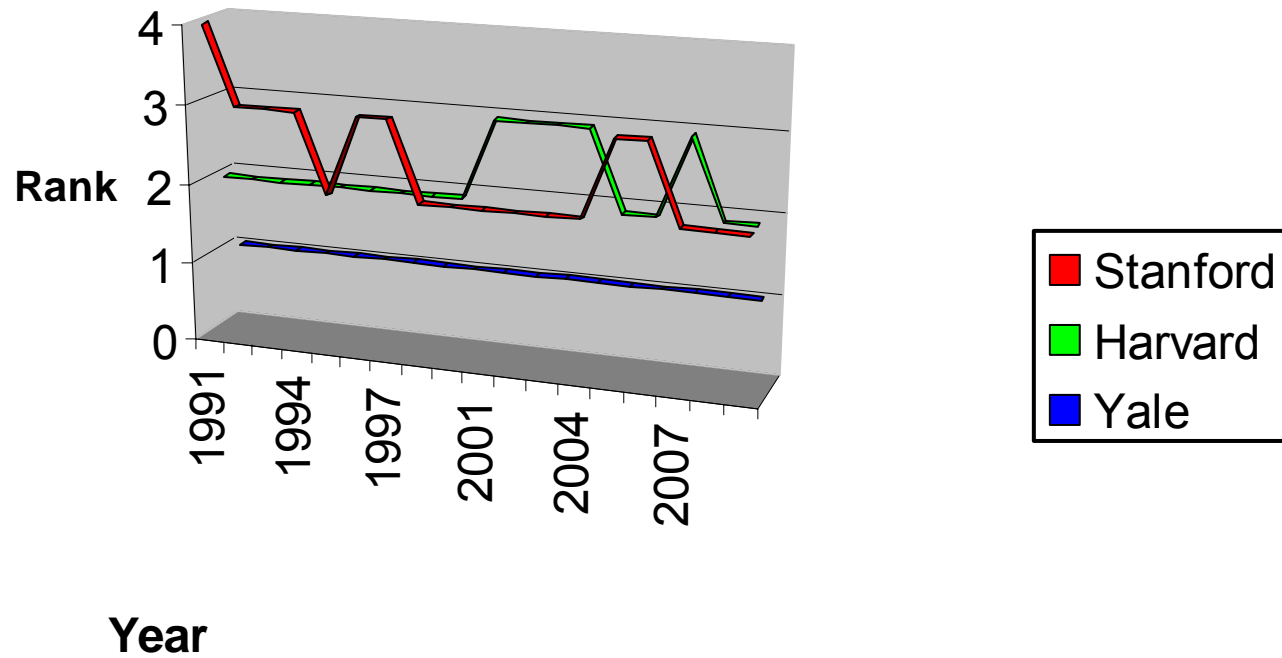
