She obtained her undergraduate degree in both Psychology and Sociology from Southern Methodist University and graduated from Southern Methodist University Dedman School of Law. Ms. Garza practiced trial and appellate criminal defense at the Dallas law firm of Sorrels, Udashen & Anton before joining the Dallas County District Attorney's Office's Appellate Division in 2008. She joined the Conviction Integrity Unit in January 2010 and has been involved in a significant percentage of the Unit's exonerations.
